ENDORSEMENT

[1] On June 15, 2023, I granted an *ex parte* Mareva injunction in favour of the plaintiff and set today as the return date. The defendants have retained counsel but require time to provide a proper response to the injunction. An extension of my order of June 15, 2023 has been negotiated with some changes including provisions to ensure the defendants are able to pay for living expenses and to specifically exclude any corporate or personal bank accounts. This new order will be sent to me for signature.

[2] I advised the parties that I am seized of the injunction portion of this proceeding. I also advised that with trials, non-sitting weeks, and holidays in July and August, I wanted to set a time for the hearing now that could be held in my calendar. Otherwise, the return of this motion may not be until mid-September.

[3] The hearing of this matter has therefore been set for July 27, 2023 at 2:00 p.m. It will be a virtual hearing.

[4] If the parties are not ready for the hearing on that date, they are to advise the court and a case conference will be scheduled before me to set a new date. That case conference should be set for 9:00 a.m. during the weeks of July 10th, 17, or 24th.
